

## HOUSE RULES

(applicable to all exhibition areas and the fortress grounds)

### Dear Visitors

We warmly welcome you to the Cultural Centre Ehrenbreitstein Fortress and wish you an exciting and informative stay. The following house rules are designed to make your visit as pleasant as possible.

The Directorate General, represented by its staff and/or persons authorised by it, exercises domiciliary rights. You must comply with their orders, which serve your safety and the protection of the cultural assets.

The house rules are binding for all visitors. When accessing the fortress grounds you accept the regulations as well as all other instructions given to maintain operational safety.

- You are entering a cultural monument with original surfaces and pathways. Special care and caution is required when visiting a historic structure. Structural peculiarities of the fortification, especially unevenness and depressions, as well as steps, low door lintels, etc., must be expected and taken into account at all times.
- Using skateboards, inline skates, city scooters, Segways, etc. is not permitted. Bringing along (pushing) bicycles is only permitted for overnight guests of the Koblenz Youth Hostel. Exceptions apply to official traffic. Unless otherwise indicated, photography in the exhibitions is permitted for private purposes without flash or tripod.
- "Haus der Archäologie" exhibition: Bulky objects of all kinds are to be handed in at the entrance area.
- Except for assistance dogs, animals are not allowed in the exhibition areas. They are welcome on the fortress grounds on a leash. Please use the appropriate receptacles for your four-legged companion's leftovers.
- Smoking is not permitted in the buildings/rooms, neither is the consumption of food and drinks in the exhibition spaces. We offer a wide range of gastronomic services in the Beer Garden and the Casino Restaurant.
- Areas may be closed within the scope of the obligation to ensure public safety and for special reasons.
- Guardians such as parents, teachers and other persons must supervise those entrusted to their care in order to prevent accidents and damage.
